

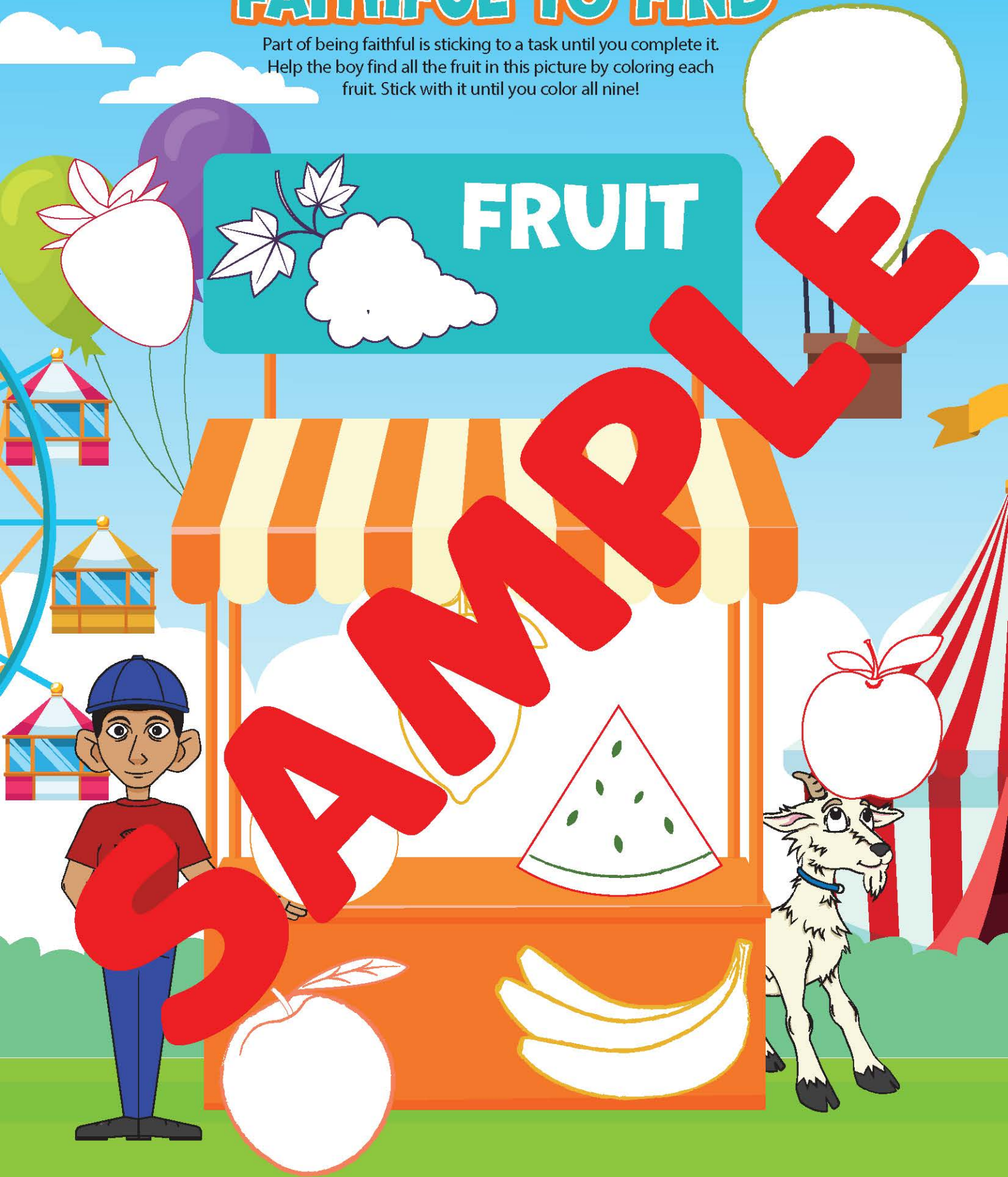
JESUS FOLLOWS GOD'S WILL

Help the boy find all the fruit in this picture by coloring each fruit. Stick with it until you color all nine!

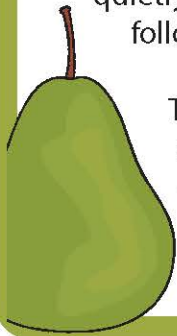

Today we heard a Bible story about Jesus' **PATIENCE** as He waited on God's timing.

After His baptism, Jesus spent forty days in the wilderness, waiting for God to lead Him and trusting God even when He was hungry and tempted. Later, at a wedding, His mother wanted Jesus to use His power to help the family who was holding the wedding. Jesus knew it was not the right time to show His power publicly. Instead, He quietly turned water into wine, patiently following God's timing.



This story reminds us that Jesus trusted God's timing in every situation. Jesus is our perfect example of **PATIENCE**.
